Green Line is a European-funded cross-border project in Slovenia and Hungary. It aims to improve the exchange of knowledge and experience for better cross-border cooperation on environmental and energy issues.

The project establishes a professional community of municipalities in the border area to improve their strategic planning through improved collaboration with other towns. In addition, they receive consulting support and get access to energy planning tools such as an on-line energy accounting system for buildings or a 3D map of the Mura-Zala geothermal basin.
